Business-inspired education

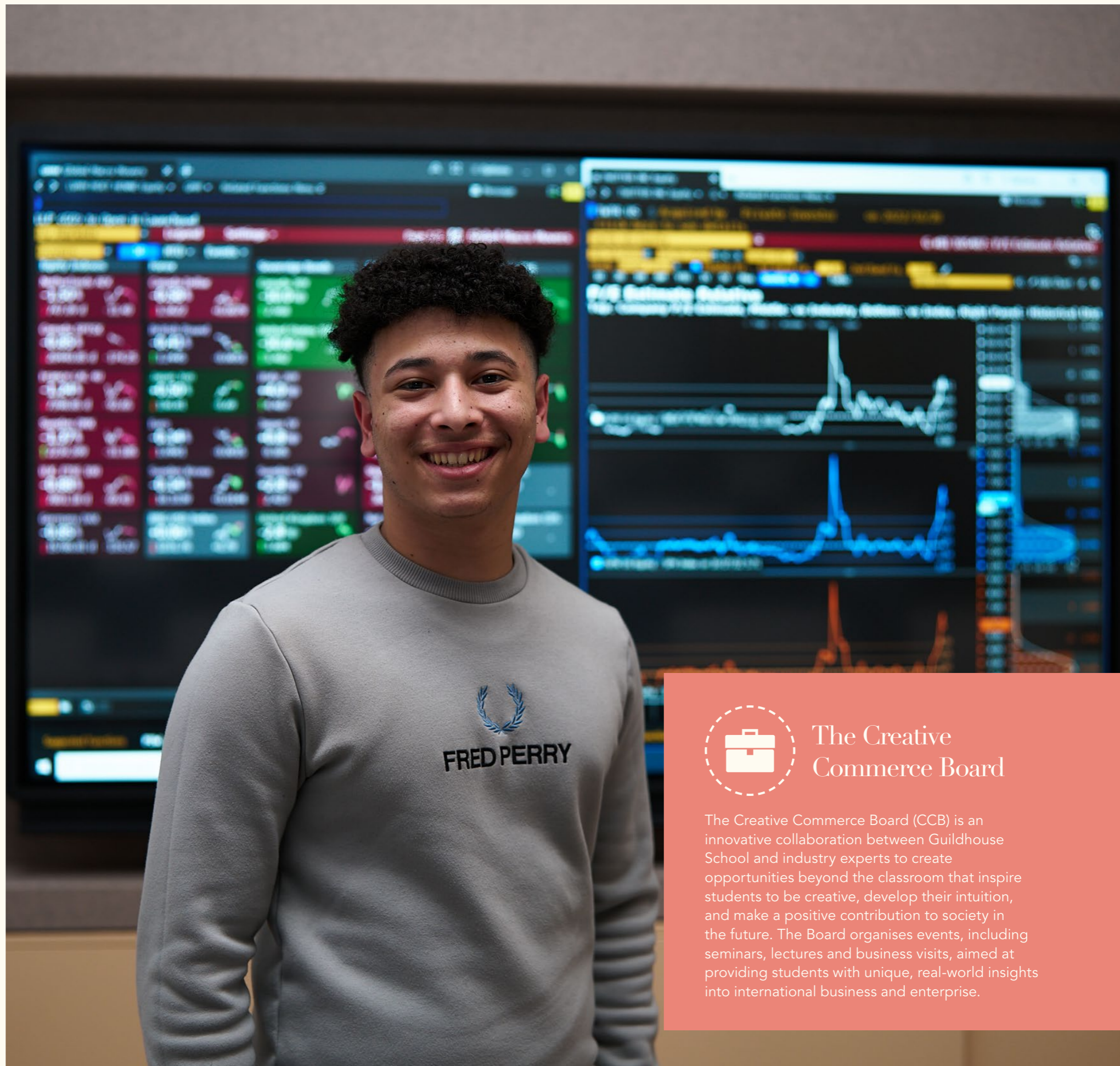

Guildhouse School is home to the only Bloomberg Lab in a high school in Europe

All our students have access to the Bloomberg Terminals and are encouraged to take the Bloomberg Market Concepts (BMC) Qualification, which offers students an unparalleled introduction to financial markets that they would not normally receive until studying at university.



Every Guildhouse student, irrespective of programme or subjects, will have the opportunity to earn the BMC qualification.

48% of students go on to a business or business or economics related degree.

The Competitive Edge

Boosts students' competitiveness for university and the job market by developing hands-on knowledge and real-world experience that most students do not gain until postgraduate study.

Higher Education Counsellors

Students are allocated a specific Higher Education Counsellor (HEC) who works with them to ensure their applications are completed to the highest possible standard and correctly submitted. The Guildhouse School HECs organise higher education lessons and workshops, organise external speakers and university visits, and oversee the university application process.

Academic Counsellor

The AC oversees preparation for university entrance exams including the UK Clinical Aptitude Test (UKCAT), the Law National Aptitude Test (LNAT) and Oxbridge additional tests along with organising work experience and practice interviews.

Key Professions Programme

For students wishing to pursue a degree in a competitive field such as law, finance, medicine, Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Maths (STEAM), or apply to Oxbridge we offer additional tailored support:

Local Lectures - we encourage students to attend lectures at London's universities and other institutions.

Work Experience and volunteering is beneficial to candidates for any degree course as it demonstrates the student's willingness and ability to contribute beyond the school.

University exam preparation - we offer support with specialist classes for UKCAT, LNAT and Oxbridge admissions exams.

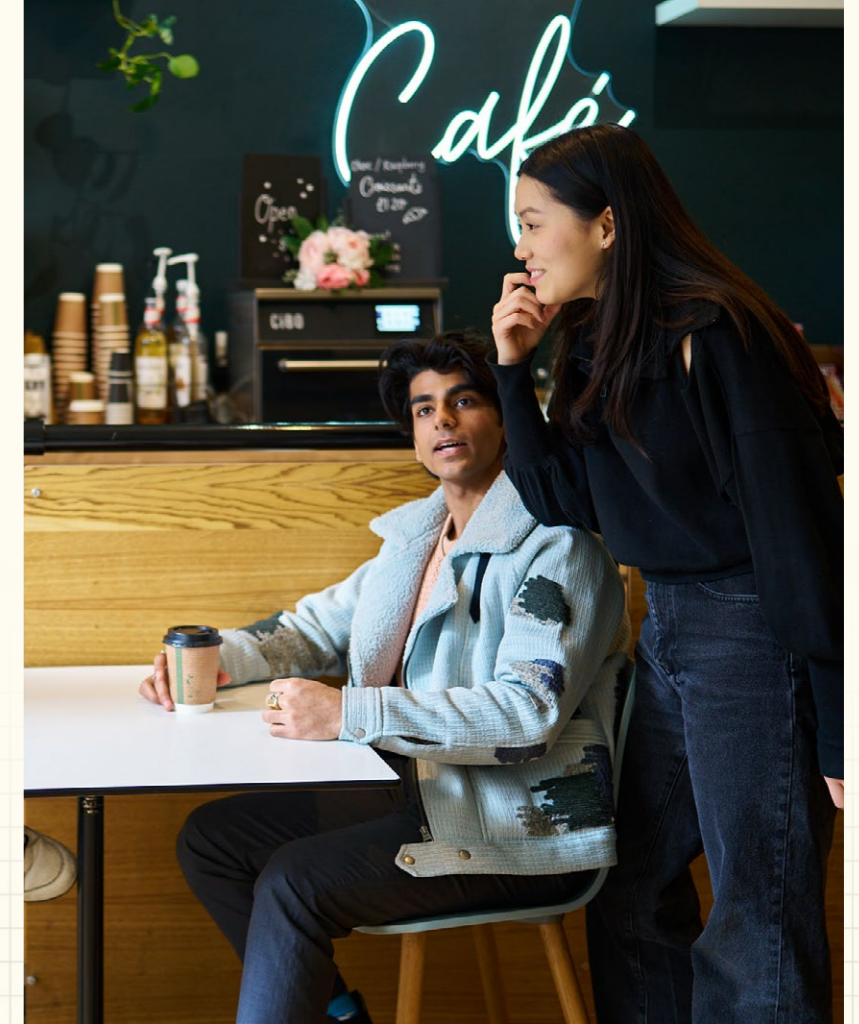

University Foundation Programme

Designed specifically for high achieving international students, the University Foundation Programme (UFP) acts as a bridge from students' high school education in their own country to university in the UK.

At Guildhouse School we offer UFP starting in September and January.

Overview

The UFP recognises the specific academic challenges that International students face and uses assessment strategies that offer the best opportunities to demonstrate a student's academic level and potential. Students each choose three academic subjects with exams at the end of the qualification. In addition, all students attend English classes designed to develop their English skills for university.

Final UFP grades are determined by exams as well as a significant amount of coursework which simulates the structure of most UK university courses.

Choosing a subject combination is important as universities look for students that have good grades in the right subjects. We work intensively with each student choose the best combination to help achieve their university and career aspirations.

A level

A levels are the classic British path into higher education and offer an excellent route to study at high ranking UK universities. A levels are a highly regarded qualification and can open the widest choice of UK universities. At Guildhouse School students can join Year 12 in both September and January to study for the A level qualification.

Overview

A levels are a focussed qualification of three subjects and English studied over two years, with examinations in the second year.

At Guildhouse School our A level delivery is specifically designed for motivated international students, with additional English language support to help them excel in their studies. We offer a wide range of subjects and work with each student to choose the best subject combinations to achieve their university goals.

Pre-A level

Pre-A level is designed as an introduction to the UK Further Education system and follows a similar approach to GCSE, but with a duration of one year or less. Students experience a wide range of subjects which prepares them to progress to study A level, although this programme is also suitable for students wishing to progress to study UFP if they are of the appropriate age.

Pre-A level offers students the opportunity to improve their English prior to moving to more advanced study and students should expect to take external exams in English and Maths. At Guildhouse School, we offer both September and January starting points for Pre-A level.

UAL Foundation Diploma in Art & Design

The UAL Foundation Diplomas are a stepping stone between general arts education and specialist university study and then creative industry employment. They are taught in the CSVPA London Studio, which is based within Guildhouse School.

The Foundation Diploma is quality-assured by the UAL awarding body through a rigorous external moderation process and grades are monitored against agreed national standards. The qualifications is also regulated by Ofqual.

You will have your own space to create and study. Our studios are designed to look, feel and operate like professional studios, which is excellent preparation for your career. We make sure you are adept at using all the latest equipment, processes and programmes that the creative industries use. Students have access to our spaces seven days a week and our lecturers provide personalised tuition. Students who take our studio-based course will have access to Apple Mac computers, design tables and gallery spaces.

Housed within the gorgeous Guildhouse School buildings, CSVPA London Studio is located in the heart of London. Students have easy access to one of the world's most exciting and creative cities.

Visual Communication, Advertising, Art Direction and Branding

This course covers the areas that underpin the visual creative arts industry. Students are introduced to the fundamentals of visual communication and graphic design for branding, advertising, and art direction. Areas of focus include layouts, composition, typography, colour work, the relationships between photography and illustration and how all these unite to give students the tools of a persuasive visual communicator.
